WHEN & WHAT:

Tuesday, February 16 – Predators: Find out who eats whom as we explore Audubon's ponds, forests, meadows, lake and river for predators - big and small. Learn about the special strategies predators use to find and capture their food.

Wednesday, February 17 – Tracks & Traces: Tracks and traces can tell us a lot about what animals are doing during the wintertime. Join us as we search for and try to understand their stories in the snow and mud.

Thursday, February 18 – Animals on Vacation: Many animals migrate to southern destinations in search of food during the winter months. Find out who is on vacation and where they go while dodging the snow and cold of Connecticut winters.

Friday, February 19 – Wonders of Winter: Winter is a great time of year to bundle up, get outside and have fun! What else can we do during these dark and chilly days? Come and explore away those winter blues at Audubon!
