In addition to the upcoming Bonaire piece, Kim has also shot Audubon stories in Kenya and Madagascar. Other photographic work has included the Westminster dog show, NASCAR, and the NFL.

During her tenure at Audubon, she has led a photo expedition to Costa Rica and Panama, and presented work at Audubon's Corkscrew Swamp Photo Safari in Naples, Florida. She has also served as a judge for Pictures of the Year, Communication Arts, and PDN. Kim received her Master's degree from the University of Missouri School of Journalism.
