Permit for Groups On Their Own at Audubon Greenwich Properties

A **free** permit is required for groups of seven (7) or more utilizing the Audubon Greenwich Center properties for hiking, walking, independent nature study or any other type of class or group outing. This does not include groups who have arranged a program with Audubon staff. The Center is a nature preserve for passive recreation and the quiet enjoyment of nature. Inappropriate uses include active games, loud music, and races. For professional photographers, a use fee is required. If your group wishes to register for a guided nature program with center staff, call for more information. There is an admission fee for non-members (\$3 adults, \$1.50 children/seniors), Group members check in at the gift shop to pay this fee. Permittees must abide by Center regulations: Stay on trails. No dogs. No bicycle riding. No alcohol. Picnic only at field north of main building. No grills, no barbecues, no fires. Do not litter. Dispose of refuse properly. Do not pick plants or disturb the natural habitat. Do not capture, feed or annoy animals. The center is open from 9 am to 5 pm every day.
